STAMP & SPACE students cannot make up classes through credit recovery, STARS, summer school, or any type of modules. STAMP & SPACE students must be placed in the STAMP/SPACE cohort. When scheduling keep in mind academic classes take precedence. STAMP & SPACE students must turn in the summer reading & writing assignments each school year. \*It is recommended that STAMP / SPACE 12th grade students enroll in calculus or statistics for math credit.
